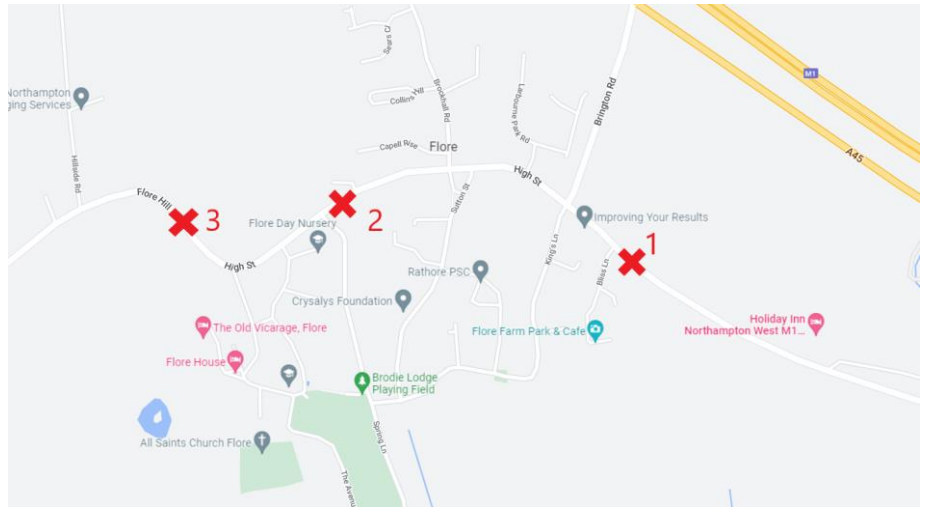

Traffic Management

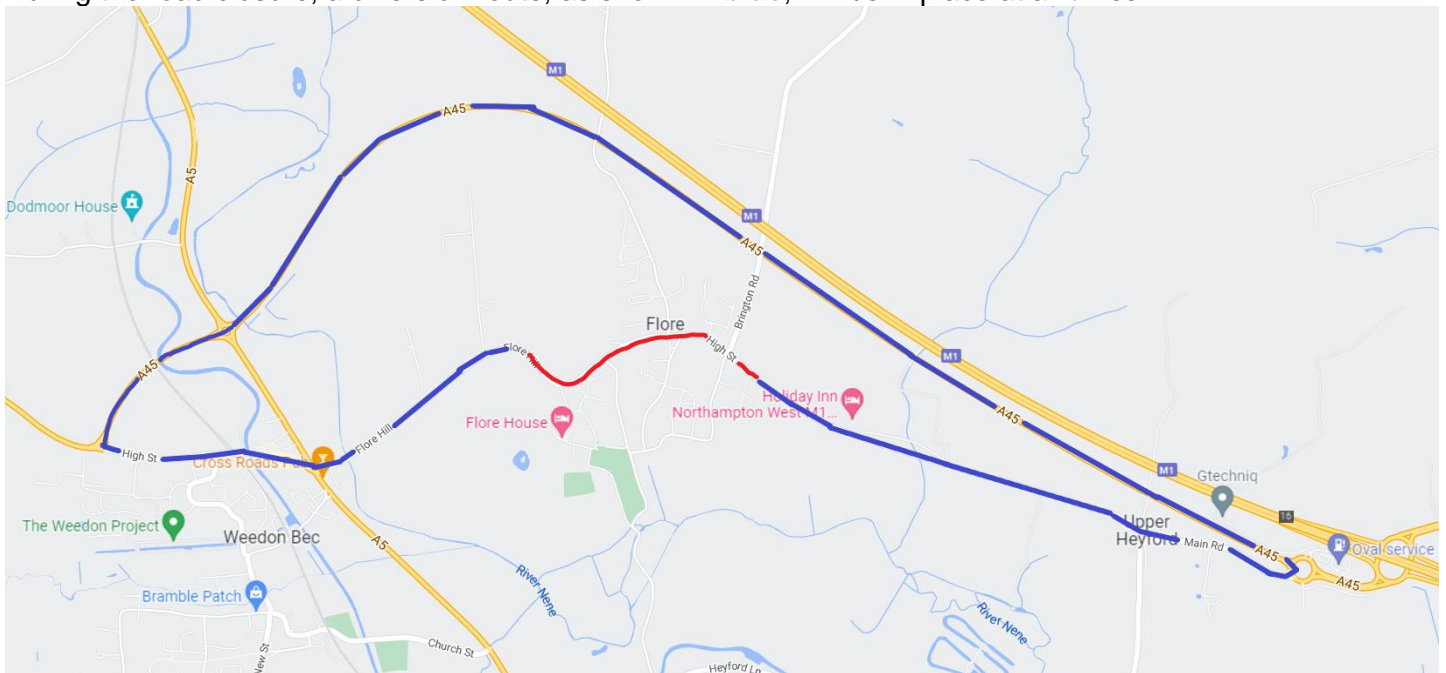
When programming works, we consider the impact on all network users and plan our works to minimise disruption as much as possible. High Street, Flore, will be closed in sections to ensure the safety of the public and our workforce within the highlighted areas in **red**.

Location number 1, approx. outside 121 High Street Flore on Monday 27 June 2022 till Friday 1 July 2022.

Location number 2, approx. outside 28 High Street Flore on Monday 4 July 2022 till Friday 8 July 2022.

Location number 3, approx. outside 1 High Street Flore on Monday 11 July 2022 till Friday 15 July 2022.

During the road closure, a diversion route, as shown in **blue**, will be in place at all times.

Information for residents and businesses

Access: There will be undisturbed access to houses and business, as we are working only on small section of the High street at one time. However, there will be no through access for vehicles. Therefore, please use the highlighted diversion route, which is the A45 Daventry Development Link Road.

Pedestrians/Cyclists: Pedestrians and cyclists will be able to cross using the footpath. Cyclists will be asked to dismount.

Public transport: during the closure, Stagecoach bus service D2 will be affected. You can find detailed arrangements during the works by visiting.
